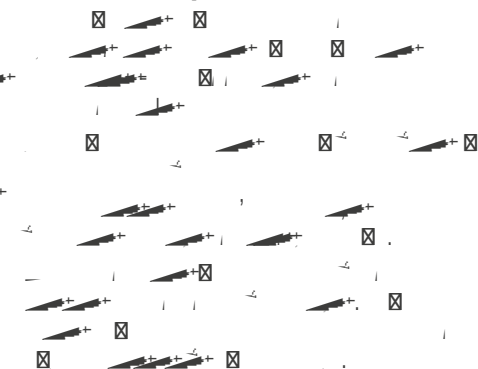
# Living with others
